Stained glass by Adam Stalony-Dobrzański,' as well as a collection of icons and copies of works by Jerzy Nowosielski.

Practical information:

The museum is located in Old Ochota, in a former boilerhouse, consisting of an Orthodox chapel dedicated to the Auschwitz martyr St. Gregory Peradze with avant-garde decoration and exhibition halls. The museum has wheelchair access.
